

40 Days of Prayer to Resurrection Sunday!

Start: March 5, 2025 (Ash Wednesday)

End: April 19, 2025 (Holy Saturday)

Theme: Seeking God's transformation in our church, families, city, and personal lives as we prepare to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

WEEK 1: Revival & Renewal in Our Church (*March 5 - March 11*)

Day 1 (Ash Wednesday, March 5) — *Personal Repentance*

- **Verse:** *"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."* — Psalm 51:10
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Confess personal sins and ask for God's forgiveness.
 - Pray for a renewed heart and a deeper hunger for God.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - What areas of my life do I need to surrender to God?
 - How can I walk in daily repentance and spiritual renewal?

Day 2 (March 6) — *Spiritual Hunger in the Church*

- **Verse:** *"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."* — Matthew 5:6
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for Del Sol Church to hunger for God's presence.
 - Ask God to increase faith and spiritual passion in every member.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - What steps can I take to grow closer to God this season?
 - Is my heart truly seeking God above all else?

Day 3 (March 7) — *Unity in the Church*

- **Verse:** *"Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."* — Ephesians 4:3
- **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for unity, love, and humility among the church family.
 - Ask God to remove division and strengthen relationships.
- **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I contributing to unity in my church?
 - How can I better love and serve others at Del Sol?

Day 4 (March 8) — *Strengthening Church Leadership*

- **Verse:** *"Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith."* — Hebrews 13:7
- **Prayer Points:**
 - Lift up the pastors and leaders of Del Sol Church.
 - Ask God to give them wisdom, strength, and protection.
- **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I encourage and support my church leaders?
 - Am I faithfully praying for those in spiritual leadership?

Day 5 (March 9) — *Equipping Church Ministries*

- **Verse:** *"To equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up."* — Ephesians 4:12
- **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for all church ministries—kids, youth, small groups, and outreach.
 - Ask God to equip leaders and volunteers to serve with passion and excellence.
- **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I use my gifts to serve in my church?
 - Am I supporting and encouraging the ministries of Del Sol?

Day 6 (March 10) — *Boldness in Faith*

- **Verse:** *"For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love, and self-discipline."* — 2 Timothy 1:7
- **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for boldness to share the Gospel in daily life.
 - Ask God to remove fear and replace it with confidence in His power.
- **Reflection Questions:**
 - When was the last time I shared my faith with someone?
 - How can I be more intentional in pointing others to Jesus?

Day 7 (March 11) — *Personal Surrender*

- **Verse:** *"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me."* — Galatians 2:20
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Surrender every area of your life to God.
 - Pray for humility, obedience, and dependence on the Holy Spirit.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - What areas of my life do I need to fully surrender to God?
 - How can I live each day with Christ at the center?

WEEK 2: Families & Marriages in El Paso (March 12 - March 18)

Day 8 (March 12) — *Strong Marriages*

- **Verse:** *"Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken."* — Ecclesiastes 4:12
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for married couples to grow closer to God and each other.
 - Ask God to heal and restore struggling marriages.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I strengthen my own marriage or support other couples?
 - Am I encouraging those around me to build their relationships on Christ?
-

Day 9 (March 13) — *Parents and Children*

- **Verse:** *"Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it."* — Proverbs 22:6
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for parents to raise their children with love, wisdom, and faith.
 - Ask God to protect children from negative influences and guide them in truth.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I better support and encourage parents in my church and community?
 - Am I setting a godly example for the children in my life?
-

Day 10 (March 14) — *Single Parents*

- **Verse:** *"A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling."* — Psalm 68:5
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Lift up single parents for strength, provision, and wisdom.
 - Ask God to surround them with a supportive community.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I offer practical help and encouragement to single parents?
 - Am I showing God's love to those facing parenting challenges?
-

Day 11 (March 15) — *Children and Teens in El Paso*

- **Verse:** *"Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers."* — 1 Timothy 4:12
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for young people to grow in faith, wisdom, and character.
 - Ask God to guide them in making wise choices and standing strong against peer pressure.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I encourage and support the youth in my church and community?
 - Am I praying regularly for the next generation?
-

Day 12 (March 16) — *Healing for Broken Families*

- **Verse:** *"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."* — Psalm 147:3
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Ask God to bring healing, forgiveness, and restoration to broken relationships.
 - Pray for families facing separation, divorce, or loss.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I know any families who need God's healing touch?
 - How can I offer support and compassion to those who are hurting?
-

Day 13 (March 17) — *Protection for Families*

- **Verse:** *"The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."* — Psalm 121:8
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for God's protection over families from harm and danger.
 - Ask for safety in homes, schools, and workplaces.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I trust God to watch over my loved ones?
 - How can I help create a safe and loving environment for those around me?

Day 14 (March 18) — *Financial Provision for Families*

- **Verse:** *"And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."* — Philippians 4:19
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for families struggling financially to experience God's provision.
 - Ask God to bless them with wisdom in managing their resources.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I help meet the practical needs of those around me?
 - Am I trusting God to provide for my own needs?

WEEK 3: Spiritual Awakening in El Paso (March 19 - March 25)

Day 15 (March 19) — *Awakening Hearts to God's Love*

- **Verse:** “*I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the Lord.*” — Jeremiah 24:7
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for spiritual awakening across El Paso.
 - Ask God to soften hearts to receive His love.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I share God's love with those around me?
 - Is my heart fully open to God's transforming power?
-

Day 16 (March 20) — *Breaking Chains of Darkness*

- **Verse:** “*The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.*” — John 1:5
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for freedom from addiction, fear, and hopelessness.
 - Ask God to break spiritual strongholds in El Paso.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Are there areas in my life where I need God's light?
 - How can I help others find freedom in Christ?
-

Day 17 (March 21) — *Bold Witnesses for Christ*

- **Verse:** “*You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses.*” — Acts 1:8
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for boldness to share the Gospel throughout El Paso.
 - Ask God to open hearts and minds to the message of Jesus.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I actively sharing my faith with others?
 - How can I be a light in my community?
-

Day 18 (March 22) — *Revival in Local Schools*

- **Verse:** “*Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them.*” — Matthew 19:14
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for students, teachers, and staff in El Paso’s schools.
 - Ask God to raise up young leaders with strong faith.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I support students and teachers in my community?
 - Am I praying regularly for the next generation?
-

Day 19 (March 23) — *Restoration of Broken Lives*

- **Verse:** “*He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.*” — Psalm 147:3
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for those struggling with emotional and spiritual wounds.
 - Ask God to restore hope and purpose to the hurting.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Who in my life needs encouragement and prayer?
 - How can I show compassion to those who are hurting?
-

Day 20 (March 24) — *Unity Among Churches*

- **Verse:** “*How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!*” — Psalm 133:1
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for unity and collaboration among churches in El Paso.
 - Ask God to break down barriers and foster a spirit of partnership.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I supporting the broader Body of Christ in my city?
 - How can churches work together to impact El Paso for Christ?
-

Day 21 (March 25) — *Citywide Revival*

- **Verse:** “*Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?*” — Psalm 85:6
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for a citywide revival that draws people to Jesus.
 - Ask God to move powerfully in homes, workplaces, and neighborhoods.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I believe God can bring revival to my city?
 - How can I be part of what God is doing in El Paso?

WEEK 4: Healing & Protection in Our City (*March 26 - April 1*)

Day 22 (March 26) — *Physical Healing*

- **Verse:** “*By His wounds we are healed.*” — Isaiah 53:5
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for those who are sick, injured, or suffering.
 - Ask God to bring healing and restoration to their bodies.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I believe God can heal physical sickness?
 - How can I pray for those in need of healing?
-

Day 23 (March 27) — *Emotional and Mental Healing*

- **Verse:** “*Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.*” — Matthew 11:28
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for those struggling with anxiety, depression, and grief.
 - Ask God to bring comfort, peace, and hope to their hearts.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I support someone going through emotional struggles?
 - Am I trusting God with my own burdens?
-

Day 24 (March 28) — *Protection from Harm*

- **Verse:** “*The Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.*” — Psalm 121:8
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for God’s protection over families, schools, and workplaces.
 - Ask God to guard the city against violence and danger.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I trust God to watch over my loved ones?
 - How can I help promote peace and safety in my community?
-

Day 25 (March 29) — *Healing from Broken Relationships*

- **Verse:** “*Bear with each other and forgive one another.*” — Colossians 3:13
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for reconciliation in families and friendships.
 - Ask God to heal wounds caused by broken relationships.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Is there someone I need to forgive?
 - How can I pursue peace and reconciliation in my relationships?
-

Day 26 (March 30) — *Protection for First Responders and Medical Workers*

- **Verse:** “*The Lord is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.*” — Psalm 91:2
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for police officers, firefighters, EMTs, and healthcare workers.
 - Ask God to keep them safe and give them strength and wisdom.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I support and encourage first responders in my city?
 - Am I praying regularly for those who risk their lives to help others?
-

Day 27 (March 31) — *Healing from Poverty and Injustice*

- **Verse:** “*He upholds the cause of the oppressed and gives food to the hungry.*” — Psalm 146:7
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for those experiencing poverty, homelessness, and injustice.
 - Ask God to provide for their needs and bring hope and opportunity.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I help meet the needs of those in my city?
 - Am I being a voice for justice and compassion?
-

Day 28 (April 1) — *God's Protection Over the City of El Paso*

- **Verse:** *“Unless the Lord watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain.”* — Psalm 127:1
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for God to watch over and protect every neighborhood in El Paso.
 - Ask God to bring peace, safety, and spiritual revival to the city.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Do I trust God's protection in uncertain times?
 - How can I be a source of hope and peace in my city?

WEEK 5: Transformation and Renewal (*April 2 - April 8*)

Day 29 (April 2) — *Renewing Our Minds*

- **Verse:** “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.” — Romans 12:2
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for personal spiritual growth and transformation.
 - Ask God to help us align our thoughts with His truth.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Are my thoughts reflecting God’s truth?
 - How can I renew my mind through Scripture and prayer?
-

Day 30 (April 3) — *Strengthening Families*

- **Verse:** “But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.” — Joshua 24:15
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for unity, love, and faith within families.
 - Ask God to strengthen marriages and parent-child relationships.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I bring God’s love into my family?
 - Am I leading my household in faith and prayer?
-

Day 31 (April 4) — *Overcoming Fear and Anxiety*

- **Verse:** “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and self-discipline.” — 2 Timothy 1:7
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for those struggling with fear and anxiety.
 - Ask God to fill their hearts with peace and confidence.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - What fears do I need to surrender to God?
 - How can I encourage others to trust in God’s peace?
-

Day 32 (April 5) — *Walking in Forgiveness*

- **Verse:** “*Forgive as the Lord forgave you.*” — Colossians 3:13
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for the strength to forgive those who have wronged us.
 - Ask God to help us release bitterness and embrace grace.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Is there someone I need to forgive?
 - How does forgiveness bring freedom and healing?
-

Day 33 (April 6) — *Growing in Faith*

- **Verse:** “*Without faith it is impossible to please God.*” — Hebrews 11:6
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for deeper faith and trust in God’s promises.
 - Ask God to help us live by faith, not by sight.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How can I strengthen my faith daily?
 - What steps of faith is God calling me to take?
-

Day 34 (April 7) — *Empowered by the Holy Spirit*

- **Verse:** “*Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord.*” — Zechariah 4:6
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for a fresh filling of the Holy Spirit.
 - Ask God to empower us to live boldly for Christ.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I relying on my strength or God’s Spirit?
 - How can I be more sensitive to the Holy Spirit’s leading?
-

Day 35 (April 8) — *Living with Purpose*

- **Verse:** “*For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works.*” — Ephesians 2:10
- **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for clarity of purpose and calling.
 - Ask God to use our gifts and talents to serve others.
- **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I using my gifts to glorify God?
 - How can I fulfill God’s purpose in my daily life?

HOLY WEEK: Remembering Christ’s Sacrifice (April 9 - April 13)

Day 36 (April 9, Palm Sunday) — *Welcoming Jesus as King*

- **Verse:** “*Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!*” — Matthew 21:9
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Praise God for sending Jesus to save us.
 - Pray that our hearts will welcome Jesus as King.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Is Jesus the King of my life?
 - How can I celebrate His presence daily?
-

Day 37 (April 10, Monday) — *Cleansing Our Hearts*

- **Verse:** “*Create in me a pure heart, O God.*” — Psalm 51:10
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for God to cleanse our hearts from sin and distractions.
 - Ask for a renewed passion for holiness and obedience.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - What areas of my heart need God’s cleansing?
 - How can I pursue holiness in my daily life?
-

Day 38 (April 11, Tuesday) — *Trusting God’s Timing*

- **Verse:** “*There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens.*” — Ecclesiastes 3:1
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Pray for patience and trust in God’s perfect timing.
 - Ask God to help us surrender our plans to His will.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - Am I trusting God’s timing in my life?
 - How can I grow in patience and faith?
-

Day 39 (April 12, Wednesday) — *Preparing Our Hearts for the Cross*

- **Verse:** “*He humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!*” — Philippians 2:8
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Reflect on the sacrifice Jesus made for our sins.
 - Pray for a deeper understanding of His love and grace.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How does Jesus’ sacrifice impact my life?
 - Am I living in gratitude for His grace?

Day 40 (April 13, Maundy Thursday) — *Living in the Power of the Resurrection*

- **Verse:** “*I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die.*” — John 11:25
 - **Prayer Points:**
 - Praise God for the victory we have through Jesus’ resurrection.
 - Pray for the hope of the resurrection to transform our lives.
 - **Reflection Questions:**
 - How does the resurrection give me hope?
 - Am I living as a witness of Christ’s victory?
