FAITH LIKE A CHILD

Part 3: "A New Beginning" (Genesis 6-9 NIV)

By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear **built an ark** to save his family. Hebrews 11:7a NIV

WHAT FAITH BUILDS IN YOUR LIFE:

1. The COURAGE to stand out in the world.

⁹ This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God. ¹⁰ Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham and Japheth. ¹¹ Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence. ¹² God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways. ¹³ So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth."

2. The COMMITMENT to obey God in the world.

¹⁴ "So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. ¹⁵ This is how you are to build it..." Genesis 6:14-15a NIV

¹⁹ "You are to bring into the ark two of all living creatures, male and female, to keep them alive with you. ²⁰ Two of every kind of bird, of every kind of animal and of every kind of creature that moves along the ground will come to you to be kept alive. ²¹ You are to take every kind of food that is to be eaten and store it away as food for you and for them." ²² Noah did everything **just as God commanded him.** Genesis 6:19-22 NIV

3. The COMPASSION to speak truth in the world.
